Sl. No.	Description	Issues/Comments/Suggestions
1.	Does the desktop/laptop meet the following recommended configuration? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2Ghz,Dual core CPU or later • 3GB RAM or higher • 160GB HDD • Dedicated USB 2.0 Port(minimum 5 ports required) Note: (Windows Vista/any 64 bit Operating System is not supported)	
2.	Have you logged in as an Administrator on your machine? Note: (In Windows 7 Confirm the User to be a proper 'Administrator' and not an 'Standard User' though the user will have Administrator privileges, also make sure the Administrator user has a Password)	
3.	Is there any previous version of the AadhaarEnrolmentClient Installed? If yes, please uninstall.	
4.	If New, have you Copied the latest version of Aadhaar Enrolment Client setup to your local computer?	
5.	Double click on the Setup exe file located directly under 5.AadhaarEnrolmentClient folder. Note: (Please refer README Doc for detailed installation steps.)	
6.	Did you create Operator/Supervisor users in system?	
7.	Did you import the user credential file to enrolment client? If not then import the user credential file using ECA. For details, refer to enrolment client administrator manual.	
8.	Did you registrar the enrolment client? If not then register the enrolment client using ECA. For details, refer to enrolment client administrator manual.	
9.	Is the Duly signed Registrar Certificate imported?	
10.	Did you install VDM software from 4.Dependency folder?	

11.	Did you install the drivers for scanner?	
12.	Did you disable integrated camera (for Laptop users only)?	
13.	Did you verify the compatible VDM? If not go to Home directory where you have saved the Client Installation folder and open dependencies folder and install the appropriate devices by going to that particular Vendor Devices folder and click on Setup.exe.	
14.	Check whether the services for respective devices are running : Go to Run → Services.msc -Check whether respective Vendor Devices are running.	
15.	To launch Aadhaar Enrolment Client go to Start-All Programs-UID Authority of India- Aadhaar Enrolment Client
